1.	Reading Results	Good results in reading but could be better. Reception: Read very well compared to other children their age. Year 1: Phonics results were outstanding and the best in the trust at 94% Year 2: Are in line with other children their age. Year 6: Slightly below and therefore we need to help in any way we can to make sure this year's year 6 are better.
2.	Reading Target Cards	These have been explained by the teacher however it is up to you to complete these either at home or during Guided Reading. Few examples of targets and what they mean (provided by the children around the table. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comparisons: Taking two books you have read and seeing how they are similar or different. • Inferences: What clues there are in the text that is not directly saying what is happening? • Opinions/Evidence: Why do you think that? • Facts/Opinions: What in the text is fact and what is someone's opinion. • Structure: Beginning/middle/end. • Summarise: What has happened in the text you have just read. This important to make sure you have understood. Targets Cards Should: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be placed into the plastic wallets provided. • Have scrap paper with them which should contain written evidence of the target you have just met/carried out. • Dated, so that it can be noted when these targets were completed. Action: All Prefects to bring their own and a selection of your classes reading target cards complete with the evidence mentioned earlier.
