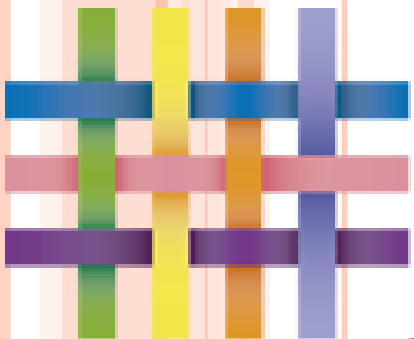

# WHAT IS TAPESTRY?

- Online Learning Journal.
- It is fully secure and only password holders can access the features.
- Parents only access their own child's Learning Journal.
- Includes the statements the teachers assess against.
- Parents can add their own comments from home.



# WHY ARE WE USING TAPESTRY?

- It increases the time spent interacting and playing with the children.
- It gives us as practitioners more time to spend planning and creating exciting learning opportunities rather than printing, cutting, sticking etc into books.
- It enables us to show you what your children really do at school which will give you opportunities to extend your child at home.



## HOW IT WORKS.

- Photos, videos and observations uploaded to Tapestry.
- Access via app or website.
- Opportunity to write back or input examples of what your child is doing outside the school day – weekend trips, exciting learning opportunities, trip to the shops etc.
- There will be new observations every week and some whole class/group learning experiences.
- Some weeks your child will have more observations.

- Videos and photographs are not to be placed on social media or shared via email/text message with those who are not on the Tapestry account.

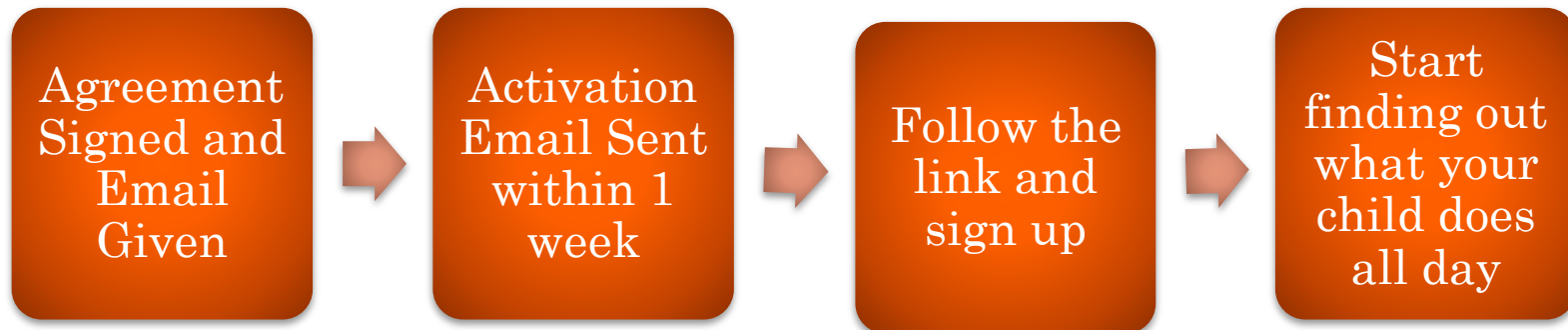
## SIBLINGS

If you have siblings in the same year group you can use the same password and email address






