

Ideas for questions to ask your child when reading

BEFORE READING:

- Can you point to the title?
- (Looking at the title and the front cover) What do you think this story will be about?

DURING READING:

- What is happening in the pictures?
- What might happen next?
- What sort of character is....? (e.g. friendly/ mean/ kind/)

AFTER READING:

- Did you like this book? Why?
- Who was your favourite character? Why?
- Can you remember what happened in the story?
- Can you act out the story?

Even better if you can have fun acting out the story together!
