Dear parents/carers,

As you are already aware this term we are studying the Victorians. We will be holding a Victorian Day in order to enrich the children's understanding and allow them to have a first hand experience of daily life during the Victorian period. This themed day will take place on Friday 30th September and children will spend the whole day in the role of a Victorian child by taking part in authentic Victorian activities.

These activities are:

- Punch and Judy show
- Making a Victorian invention
- Playing Victorian games
- Victorian school day activities

In order to make the experience as realistic as possible we ask that your child dresses in a period appropriate costume. If this is not possible, we ask that your child comes in school uniform as normal.

Here are some examples of what children can wear:

- White dresses
- White shirts
- Waistcoats
- Dark coloured trousers
- Cloaks/ shawls
- Plimsolls
- Hats e.g. bonnets, flat caps.
